FOCUS GROUP REPORT

The Union of Working Consumers of Greece, completed the report that was based on the results of the focus groups which was conducted to collect data from the experience of unemployed adults up to 29 years of age in Consumer Education within the framework of the Erasmus + European Program entitled "Development of the Key Competences of Adults by Innovative Program of Consumer Education".

The data that are extracted and evaluated in the report, will be utilized for the design of a training program for unemployed adults aged up to 29 who are a vulnerable group as they have not completed secondary education and are characterized by a lack of qualifications and skills.

In the report, we analyzed the participants experiences, their preference to the fields of Consumer Education and the necessity of the training, and at the end, we exploited their ideas concerning the knowledge-skills that is need in order to design an Innovative Educational Program.
